This Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees will confer tenure on [35 faculty members](#) tonight at seven at 333 E. Eighth St., the most promising item on a relatively light agenda. A reception honoring the newly permanent, also in the boardroom, precedes the regular meeting from 5-7 p.m.

Chancellor Fran White, the interim tapped to replace Jowel C. Laguerre at the last board meeting, will win some job security this evening, as trustees get set to offer her a 13-month contract. A host of college-level administrators will see their deals re-upped as well.

The BoT will mull a change order in the contract with the firm building CoA's New Center for Liberal Arts. The agenda item vaguely explains that "Items shown on drawings included in the contract documents were not found in the locations or configurations indicated or were not found at all; many items were encountered that are not shown at all on those drawings. Some items anticipated to be active were actually no longer in service and vice versa." Far more concrete is the sum requested: \$347,083.01.

And, of course, the Old Faithful of board agendas—the chancellor's evaluation--appears yet again. PFT will continue to investigate the mystery of this perpetually unaddressed item.
