Tonight at seven the Peralta Community College District Board of Trustees returns to the boardroom at 333 E. Eighth St., the first regular BoT meeting since the dramatic dismissal of a host of PCCD administrators, including longtime VC of General Services [Sadiq Ikharo](#) (whose interim replacement will be announced tonight).

An agenda item calling for a first reading of revised [BP 6250](#), a policy that could encroach on negotiable issues by mandating a 10% reserve, has been pulled. PFT remains concerned, however, that establishing reserves at twice the state-recommended level will threaten faculty positions and part-time parity efforts.

The board will further consider adding a new administrative salary range for interim/acting chancellors (\$223K-\$343) and an executive-level district position, Executive Administrator to the Retirement Board of Authority.

Also up for the board's consideration: \$46K in consulting fees with Collaborative Brain Trust, Interim Chancellor [Fran White](#)'s old outfit, to orchestrate the search for a new permanent chancellor. PFT reminds the district, trustees, and CBT to review [BP 2431](#) carefully.

And, of course, the chancellor's evaluation appears on the agenda. Again.

In other news:

*Don't miss the PFT general membership meeting, today, Tu., March 26, 12-1 p.m., in Room C 201 at CoA. Agenda items include the close of nominations to the PFT Executive Council, a negotiations update, consideration of recent EC motions and resolutions, and a report on the ongoing membership drive.
