## Protect student needs!

The District has cut classes from the 2018-19 schedule, citing lack of funding.

However in the last 5 yrs. the District admin. budget grew by 50% versus 26% for our College budgets!

- ◆ Do we have the money? Yes, it's called Measure B, the parcel tax passed 6 years ago. In the past 3 years, only 15% of Measure B has been spent on classroom instruction! The \$1.4 million in the Measure B reserve could be used to restore the cut classes.
- ◆ These proposed cuts will hurt students by giving them less choice. They'll take longer to get their degrees and certificates, and to transfer. This also means part-time faculty will lose jobs, a group that is already vulnerable, with 16.3% on welfare.
- ◆ Stop class cuts and keep funding at 2017-18 levels by investing directly in the classroom!
