

The Peralta Community College District (“District”) and the Peralta Federation of Teachers (“PFT”) have met in good faith and hereby agree to the following changes to Article 14, Section H, Paragraph 3, (e) on a temporary or “pilot” basis from the date of signing and expiring on June 30, 2027.

e. Notice whether the assignment is “ancillary,” or counted towards the 67% load limit for part-time faculty as defined by Ed Code section 87482.5 subsection (c)(i) and further clarified below.

1) Activities to be considered non-ancillary (and therefore part of the 67% part-time load limit):

- Project Coordinators
- Program Directors
- Department Chairs

2) Activities to be considered ancillary (and therefore not eligible for consideration of the reclassification of part-time faculty to full-time status):

- Grant funded activities outside of teaching, counseling, library services, mental health services, and college nursing services
- Stipends under the 0.10 FTE required to trigger Article 14H
- All other ZZOIS positions
